4 Winds Original Convocations

Preamble

We, the undersigned, acknowledging the sovereign authority of God and the call to obedience under His Word, do hereby establish this record of original convocations to serve as the foundational declarations, guiding values, spiritual affirmations, and operational framework for all ministries formed under the name of 4 Winds. These convocations articulate the origin, purpose, and enduring intent of the 4 Winds Cabinet and its global directives.

I. Foundational Declarations

1. The Authority of Scripture - We affirm the inspired and authoritative nature of the Holy Scriptures, both the Tanakh and the Brit Chadashah (Old and New Testaments), as the final rule for faith, direction, correction, and conduct.
2. The Lordship of Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah - We proclaim Yeshua as the Messiah, Son of God, Savior of all mankind, and the one to whom all authority in heaven and on earth has been given.
3. Unity in the Body - We affirm the unity of believers, Jew and Gentile, under one covenantal promise extended through faith in Yeshua, and we commit to promoting reconciliation between all branches of God's covenant people.
4. Global Mandate - We acknowledge the call to go into all nations, making disciples, demonstrating the love of God, and proclaiming His Kingdom come through action, word, and faithful presence.
5. The Power and Presence of the Holy Spirit - We affirm the continuing work of the Holy Spirit to empower, guide, and comfort the people of God in holiness, discernment, and mission.

II. Purpose of 4 Winds

1. To operate as a prophetic and apostolic ministry, discerning the direction of the Spirit and moving accordingly across national, ethnic, and denominational boundaries.
2. To serve as a governance and accountability structure through the 4 Winds Cabinet, ensuring order, vision, and doctrinal integrity.

3. To provide spiritual, logistical, and relational oversight to all affiliated missions, ministries, and partnerships.
4. To support and raise up leaders called to serve in regions where traditional church governance is absent or insufficient.
5. To act as a reconciling force among divided peoples, especially between the Church and the Jewish people, and between the marginalized and the recognized.

III. Convocational Commitments

Each Cabinet Member, Advisor, Field Worker, or Affiliated Minister under 4 Winds agrees to the following:

1. To uphold the declarations above in faith and practice.
2. To submit to the leadership and discipline of the 4 Winds Cabinet in matters of doctrine, direction, and correction.
3. To steward resources with integrity and transparency.
4. To serve without partiality or favoritism, demonstrating mercy, justice, and humility.
5. To engage in prayer, fasting, and the pursuit of holiness as an ongoing spiritual lifestyle.

IV. Mandate for the Future

Covenant Chair Commitment:

The 4 Winds structure includes a Covenant Chair—a unique position of enduring oversight and spiritual continuity. This Chair is reserved for a founder or an appointed founder's representative. It is intended to safeguard the original covenantal intent of the ministry and to provide wisdom and resolution in seasons of transition.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Two full terms (3 years each) served as Principal Chair.
- Two full terms (3 years each) in another Cabinet Chair.
- No exception is permitted, except in the case where the Founding Principal Chair steps down to assume

this role.

The original signatories of this convocation acknowledge that the work of 4 Winds is ongoing, evolutionary, and Spirit-led. Therefore, amendments to the applications of this document may occur under the unanimous agreement of the active 4 Winds Cabinet, provided they do not contradict the spirit and doctrine of these foundational declarations.
